The Route 2 Transfer & Recycling Station is now offering Zero-Sort® Recycling. What does this mean for you?

Zero-Sort Recycling is a state-of-the-art process that saves time and effort by allowing you to toss cardboard, paper, plastic, glass, and metal together in one bin without the need to separate recyclables. No sorting on your end means more time to enjoy life! A list of acceptable recyclable items is listed below. Please **empty** and **rinse** all containers.



### CARDBOARD

Boxboard, corrugated cardboard, product and food packaging boxes such as cereal, pasta, pizza, and tissue, paperboard boxes, beverage holders, paper towel cores, toilet paper cores, and paper bags



### PAPER

Newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, magazines, soft cover books, file folders, any color paper, paper cartons such as milk, egg, and juice boxes



### PLASTIC

Containers, bottles and jugs #1-#7 such as food, beverage, beauty, and cleaning products, detergents, dairy tubs such as yogurt and sour cream, plastic take-out containers, flower pots, and trays

**Large rigid plastic items such as:** 5-gallon buckets, sleds, soda crates, laundry baskets, and kids toys



### GLASS

Food and beverage containers, and jars of any color



### METAL

Household and kitchen items such as aluminum soda and beer cans, pie plates, trays, foil, tin cans (food cans, coffee cans, and pet food cans), and small steel containers

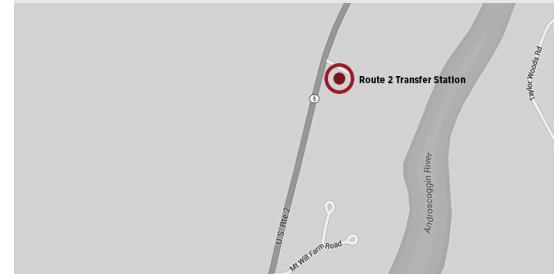
### NOT ACCEPTED

Plastic bags or wrapping, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, paper towels, facial tissue, styrofoam, recyclables containing food waste, paints, oils, hazardous material, needles, syringes, VCR tapes, CDs/DVDs, scrap metal, pots, pans, batteries, hard-cover books, clothing/textiles, wood/lumber, yard trimmings, 3-ring/spiral notebooks
