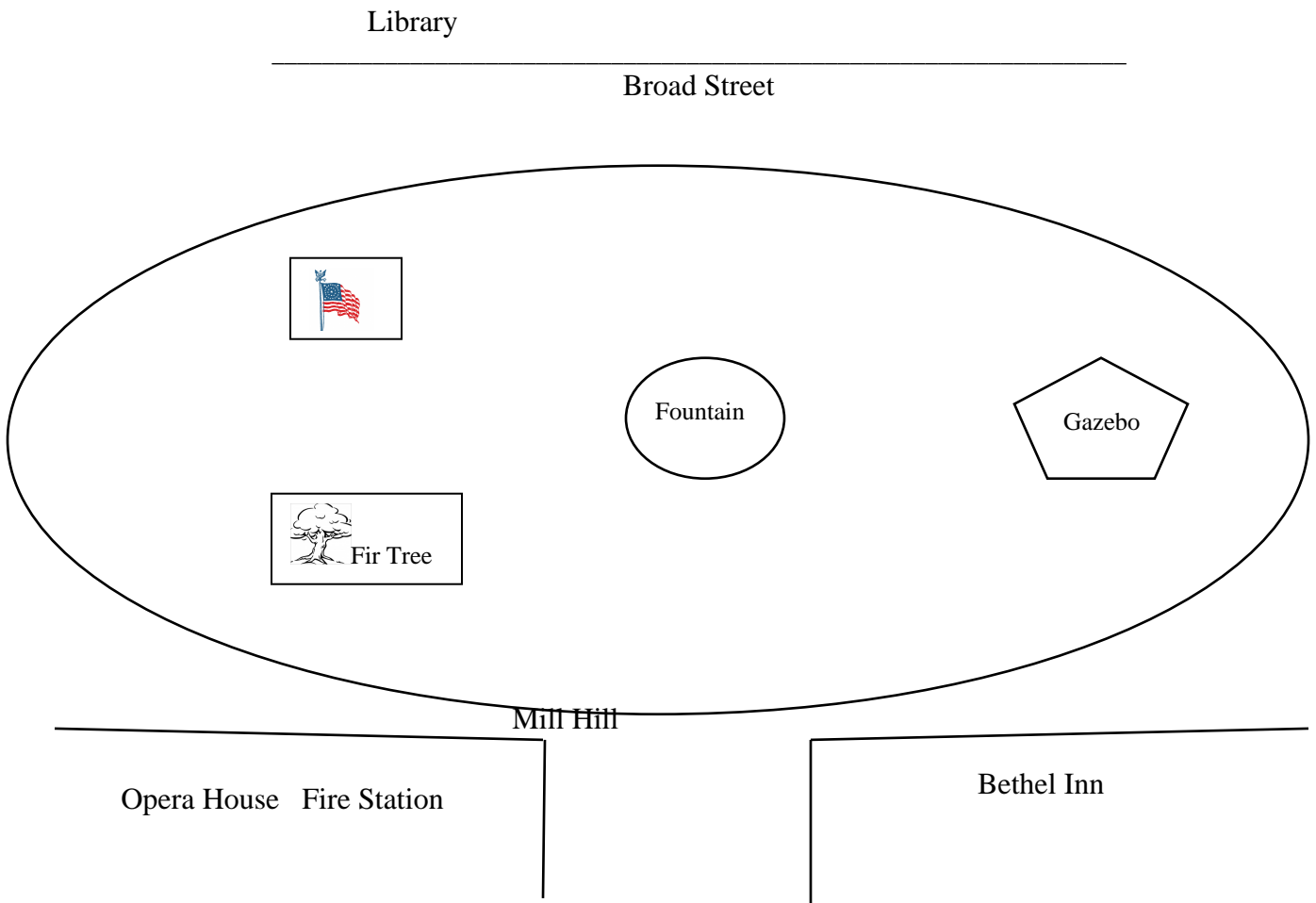
RULES SURROUNDING USE OF TOWN PROPERTY

- Absolutely no alcohol is to be consumed or distributed on town property.
- The consumption of marijuana on town property is prohibited.
- The area rented must be brought back to the original condition it was rented in.
- Liability Insurance for \$1 million must be presented when the application is submitted. The rental party may purchase their own liability insurance waiver with the Town of Bethel as additional insured. Attached is a brochure for insurance should you so desire to use their services. (The town does not make money off this insurance, but simply provides the information as a courtesy.)
- The area must be free and clear of all trash, exhibits and other additional items within 24hrs of the event conclusion.

It is hereby understood that the deposit fee will not be returned and that the person or organization responsible for the activity will be billed for additional clean-up activities that are not completed by the date specified on the use permit. It is also understood that the insurance liability waiver provided will remain in effect throughout the date(s) specified.

Protect yourself from claims for injuries or property damage during your event

Are you planning to use or rent a city facility?

TULIP ensures you are protected from liability for injuries and damage that may occur at your event or activity.

Without TULIP, you may be personally responsible for paying claims for bodily injury or property damage during your event or activity. Your homeowner's insurance may cover some situations, but it may be limit-ed and not all claims will be covered.

You can buy insurance through TULIP, a city-sponsored program, or you can purchase a policy through another private insurance carrier.

What does TULIP cover?

This city-sponsored program provides \$1 million in liability coverage for events* such as:

- Receptions
- Reunions
- Festivals
- Concerts
- Job Fairs
- Weddings
- Clubs & Meetings
- Arts & Crafts Fairs
- Many more!

Can I get liquor liability coverage from TULIP?

Yes. Liquor liability coverage is available.

How does TULIP work?

Your city has made TULIP coverage available for purchase through a collection of cities and insurers.

After entering event information into the secure web site, an instant quote is generated. Coverage can be purchased online with a credit card.

How much does TULIP cost?

The cost for the \$1 million liability coverage depends upon your unique event, *including things such as:*

- Length of event.
- Number of attendees.
- Whether there are exhibitors or vendors.
- Whether food and alcohol are served.

Tenant User Liability Insurance Program (Why The Need?)

Requests to use municipal property and facilities by the public have become a common occurrence. While it is comforting knowing that the municipality is covered through MMA, independent entities that use your municipal facilities are not. This opens the possibility of the municipality becoming drawn into unnecessary claims.

The Solution to this dilemma is the Tenant Users Liability Insurance Program (TULIP). TULIP is a low-cost insurance policy that protects both the "Tenant User" and the municipality. A "Tenant User" is any outside party using town or school facilities. The policy applies to bodily injury or property damage arising out of the use of municipal premises by Tenant Users. Premium costs are traditionally paid by the Tenant Users or by the department inviting the Tenant User

into the facility. Premium costs are based on the nature of the event, the duration of the event, the number of participants, the level of risk of the event and any special requirements.

Coverage & Limits

Coverage limits of \$1 million are available for products/completed operations, including liability for bodily injury and property damage. The policy will pay those sums that the insured (the tenant user) becomes legally obligated to pay as damages because of bodily injury or property damage to which this insurance applies.

Coverage Includes:

- Premises Operations
- Products/Completed Operations
- Contractual Liability
- Broad Form Property Damage
- Personal Injury Liability
- Limits are outside cost of defense (Therefore, cost of defense is in addition to the limit of liability for any coverage.)

How It Works

- The Municipality is registered to use the TULIP program account through HUB International New England at no cost.
- When a Tenant User wants to use the facility, the facility management directs the Tenant User to www.onebeaconentertainment.com and provides a seven-digit ID code that identifies the facility.
- The Tenant User enters the ID code and answers a few basic questions in a three-step process that provides an online quote.
- If the Tenant User decides to purchase coverage through the facility's TULIP program, they simply enter their credit card information and coverage is bound. A Certificate of Insurance is automatically sent to the facility, the Tenant User and the broker.

Your Tenant User now has access to generate a quote and bind General Liability insurance via the TULIP online system!
