

ZERO SORT RECYCLING:

(Accepted materials are subject to change.)

- **Cardboard**

- Boxboard, corrugated cardboard, product and food packaging boxes such as cereal, pasta, and pizza boxes, beverage holders, paper towel cores, paper bags

- **Paper**

- Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, soft cover books, file folders, color paper, paper cartons

- **Plastic**

- Containers, bottles and jugs #1-#7 such as food, beverage, beauty, and cleaning products, detergents, dairy tubs such as yogurt and sour cream, plastic take out containers, flowerpots and trays
- *Large rigid plastic items* such as 5-gallon buckets, sleds, soda crates, laundry baskets and kid's toys

- **Glass**

- Food and beverage containers, and jars of any color

- **Metal**

- Aluminum soda and beer cans, pie plates, trays, foil, tin cans and small steel containers

NOT ACCEPTED

Plastic bags or wrapping, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, paper towels, facial tissues, Styrofoam, recyclables containing food waste, needles, syringes, VCR tapes, CDs, DVDs, scrap metal, pots, pans, batteries, hard cover books, clothing, wood/lumber, yard trimmings, 3-ring/spiral notebooks.

Paints, oils, and hazardous materials are ONLY ACCEPTED ON HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY. Check with the Town Office for yearly dates.

Restrictions and Regulations

This processing facility may only handle wood waste such as stumps and brush. It may not accept painted wood, chipboard, plastic, wood with fasteners, nails, paint or wood that is otherwise contaminated.

WOOD, STUMPS, LEAVES AND 6 INCH DIAMETER WOOD AND ABOVE.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS

- **Creosote**
- **Dirty wood with attached siding/roofing/metal, etc.**
- **Doors/Windows & Casings**
- **Flooring/Molding**
- **Mixed loads**
- **Other Construction Debris**

efficient use of the Transfer Station we
have the following Transfer Station sticker
requirements:

Residents/Property Owner
\$10.00 per sticker per vehicle
Proof of residency upon purchase
Each sticker will have your vehicle plate
number listed or home address
Stickers are valid for the dates listed.

Short Term Rentals
A Temporary Vehicle Pass (\$5.00) can be
issued to a renter once the property owner
has provided the Town Office, by phone or
email, the renter's name and the rental dates.

Contractors
Contractors working on property in Bethel,
Hanover and Newry may obtain a Temporary
Vehicle Pass (\$5.00). The property owner
must notify the Town Office by phone or email
of the contractor's name and the project
dates.

All property owners and residents must
purchase a Transfer Station Sticker (\$10.00)
prior to the issuance of a Temporary Vehicle
Pass (\$5.00).

Vehicles without a sticker or temporary pass
will not be allowed access to the Transfer
Station.

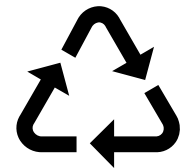
